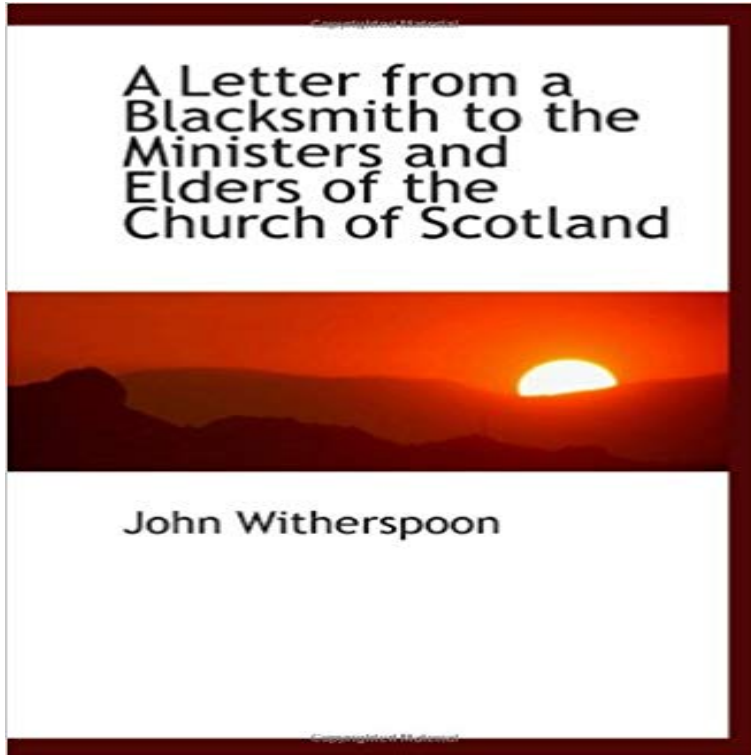


A Letter from a Blacksmith to the Ministers and Elders of the Church of Scotland
