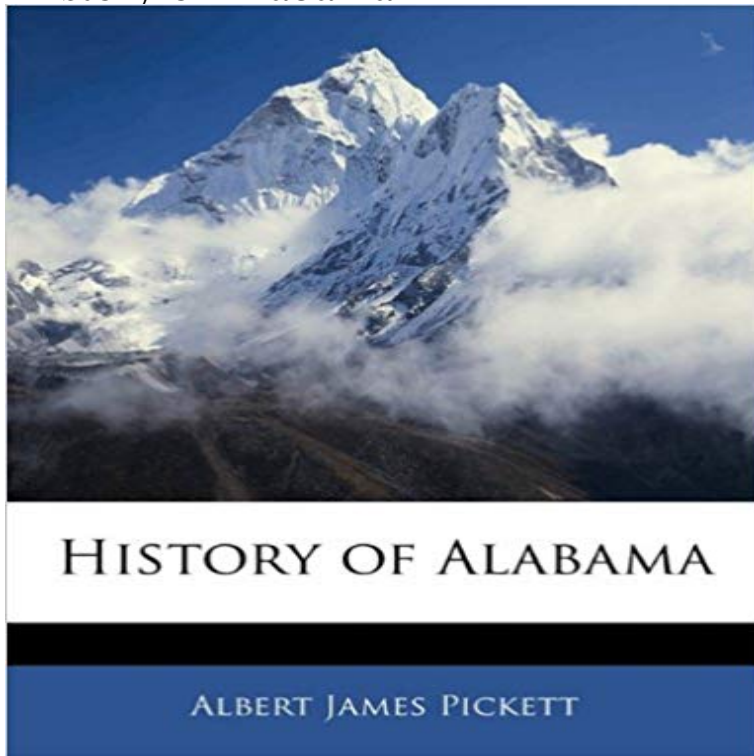


History of Alabama
