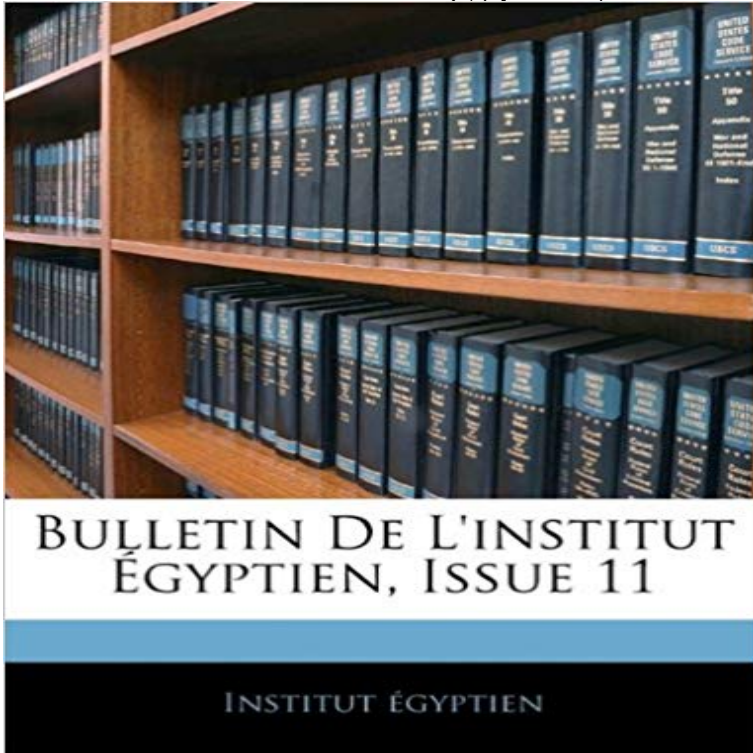


## Bulletin De L'institut Egyptien, Issue 11 (French Edition)
