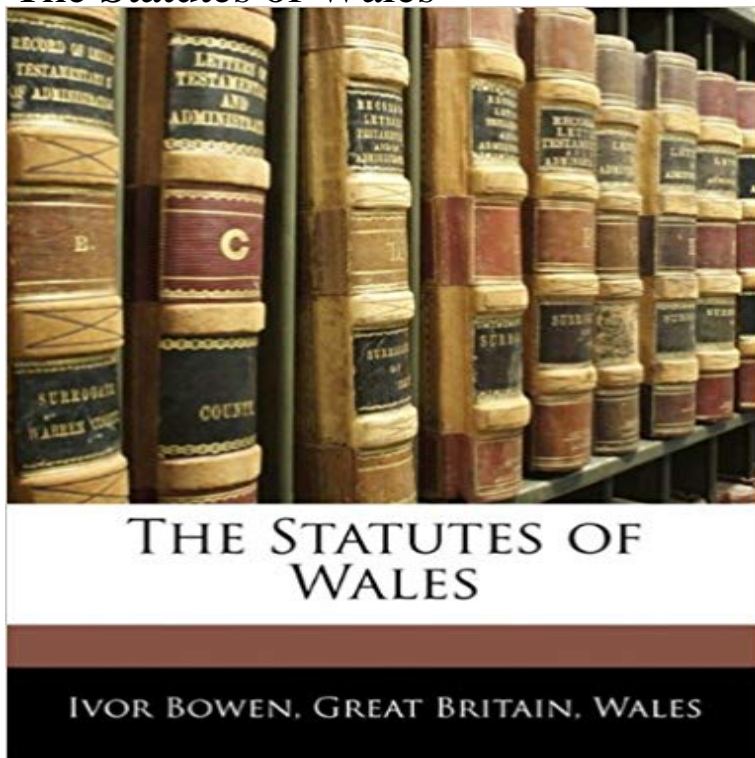


The Statutes of Wales
