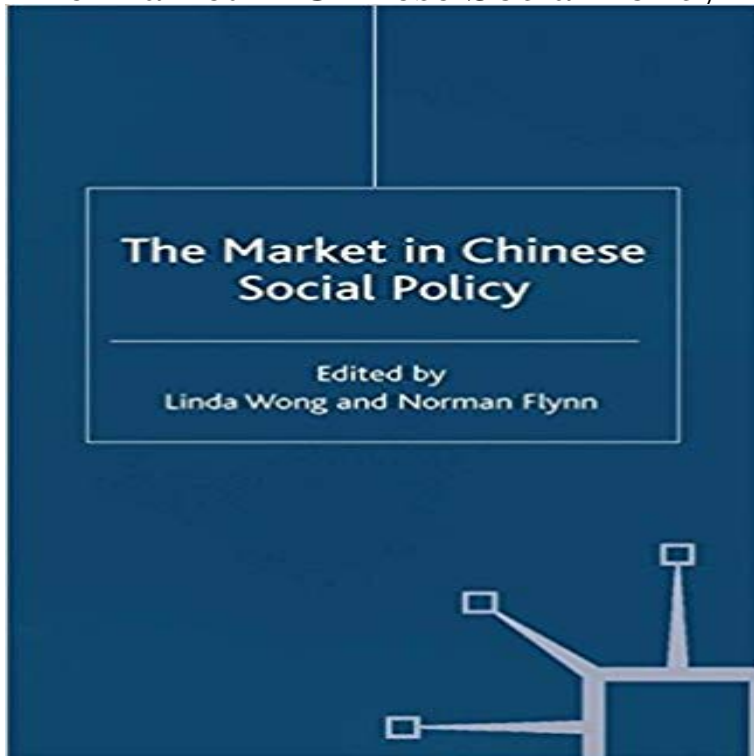


The Market in Chinese Social Policy
