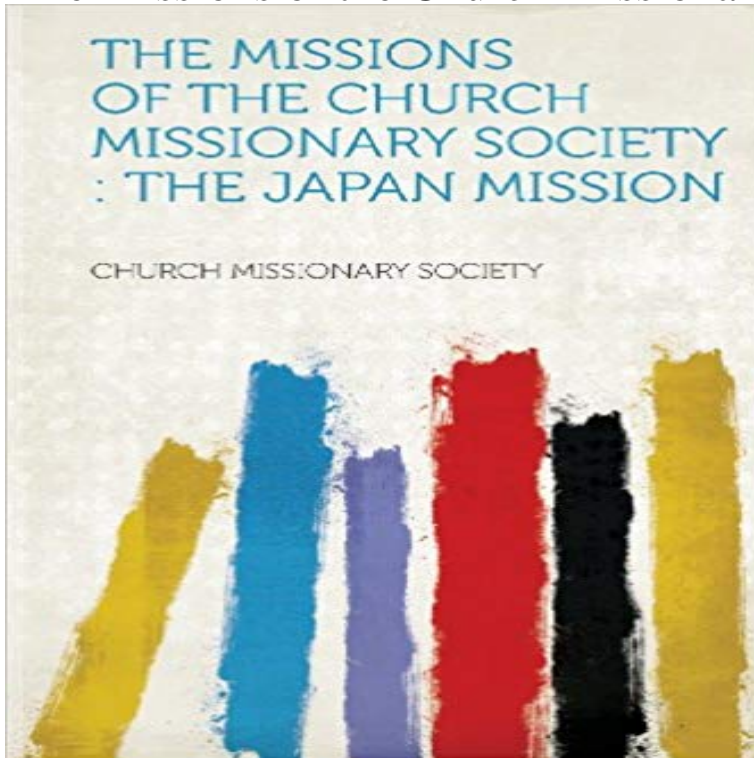


The Missions of the Church Missionary Society: the Japan Mission
