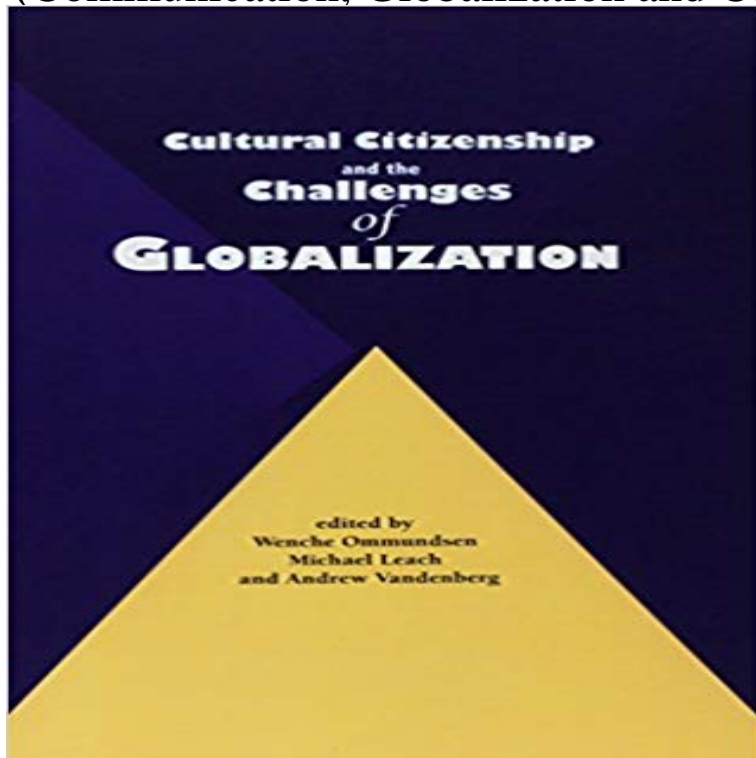


Cultural Citizenship and the Challenges of Globalization (Communication, Globalization and Cultural Identity)
