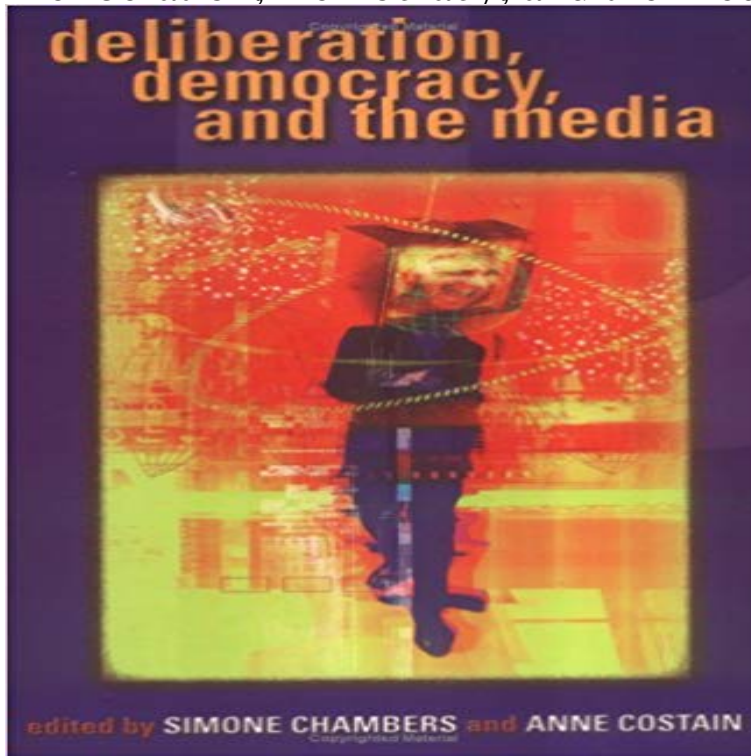


Deliberation, Democracy, and the Media
