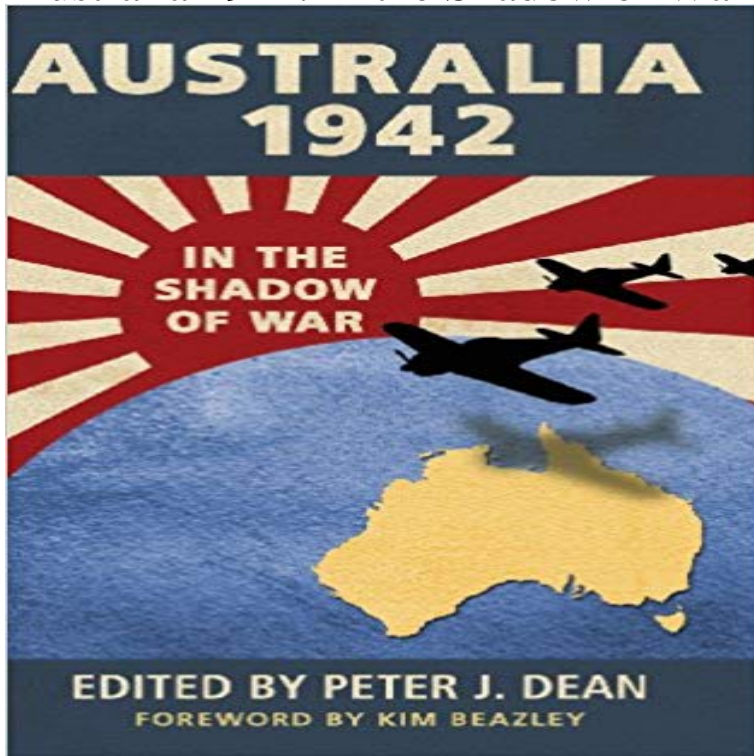


Australia 1942: In the Shadow of War (Australian Army History)
