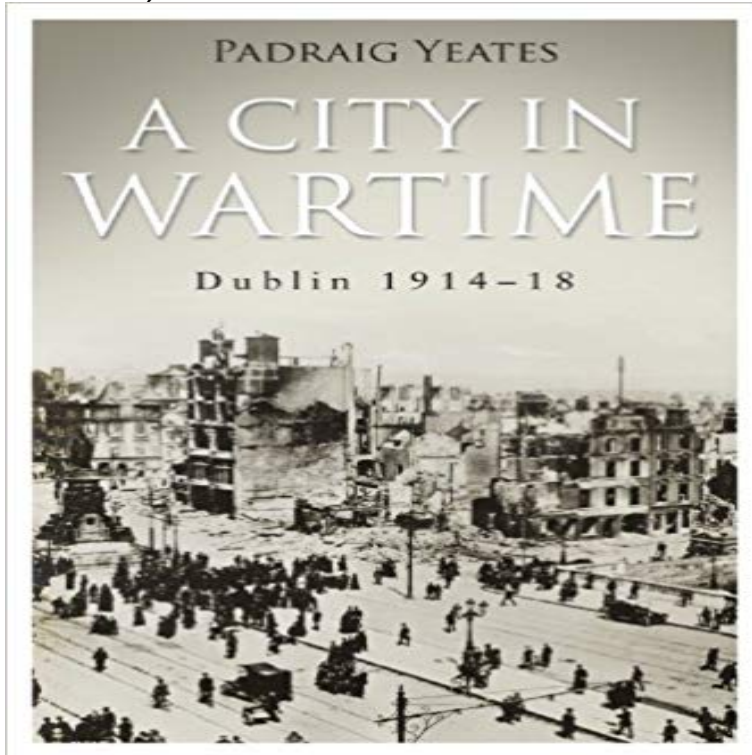


A City in Wartime - Dublin 1914-1918: The Easter Rising 1916 (Dublin at War)
