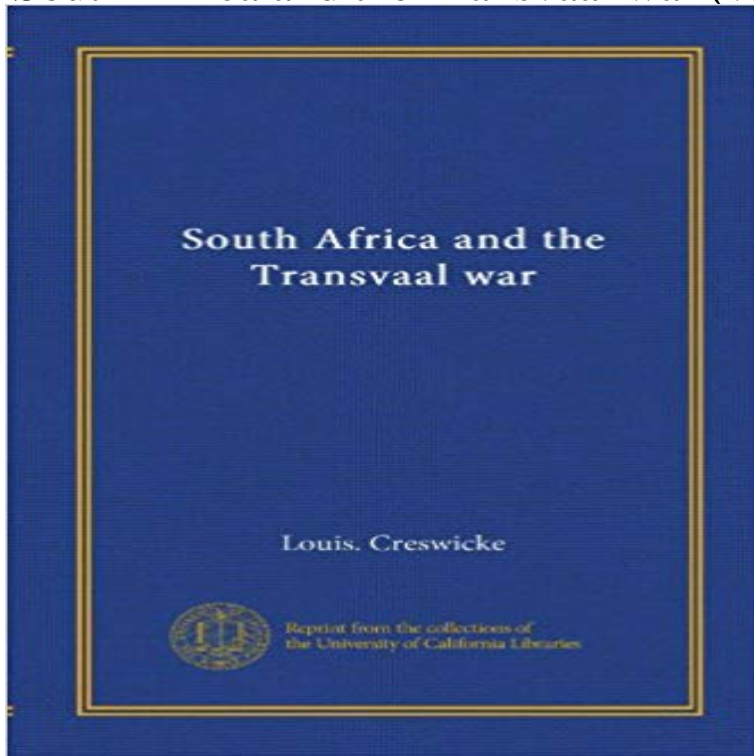


South Africa and the Transvaal war (v.6)
