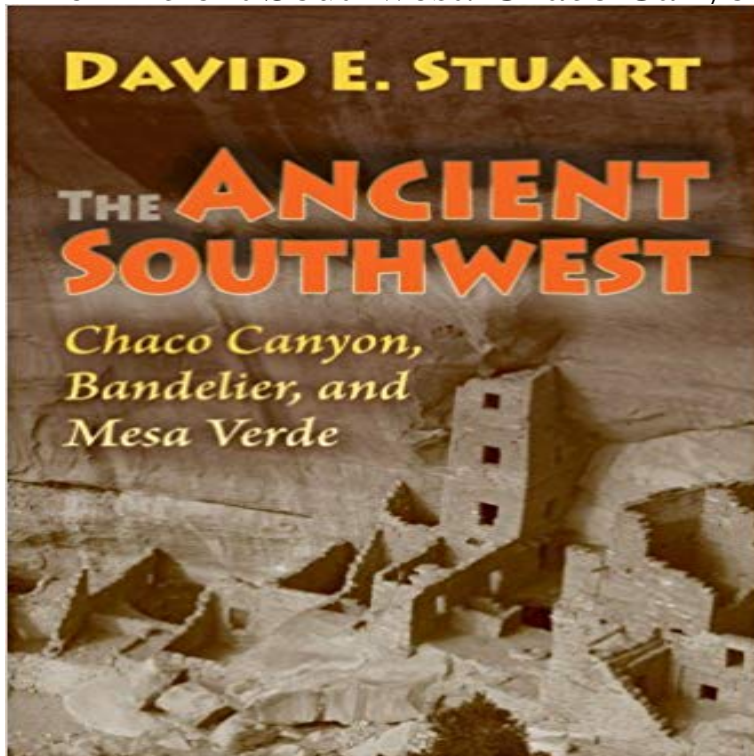


The Ancient Southwest: Chaco Canyon, Bandelier, and Mesa Verde
