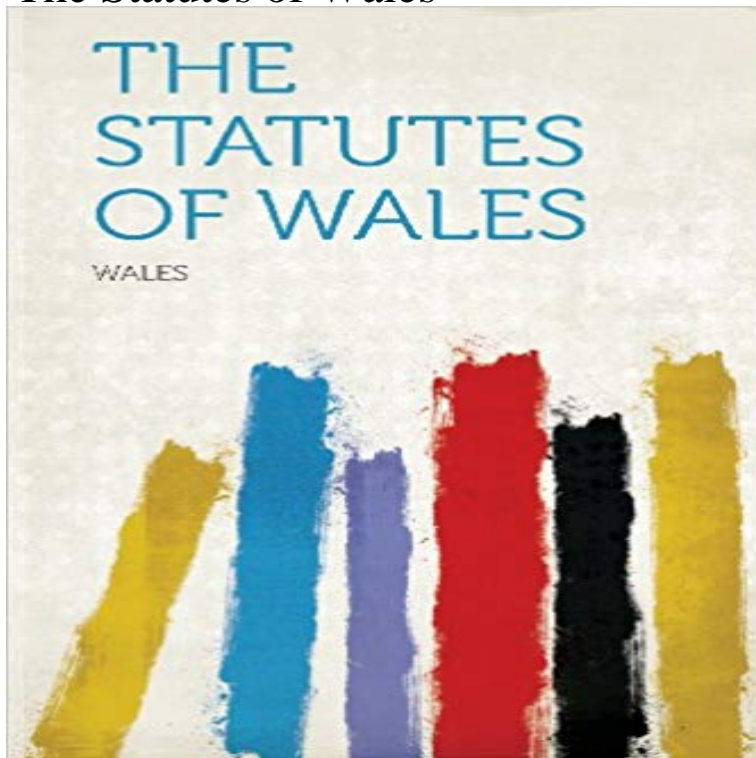


# The Statutes of Wales
