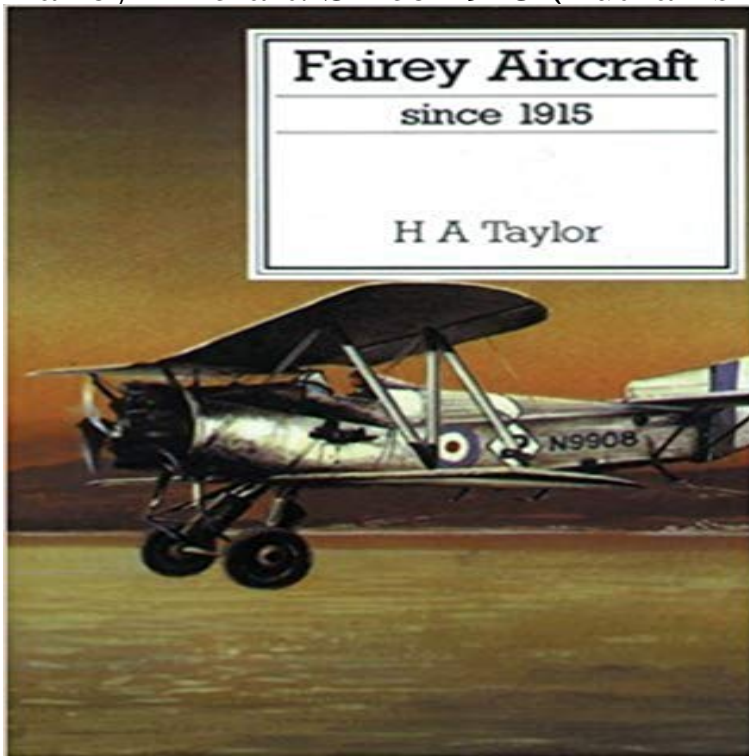


## Fairey Aircraft: Since 1915 (Putnams British aircraft)
