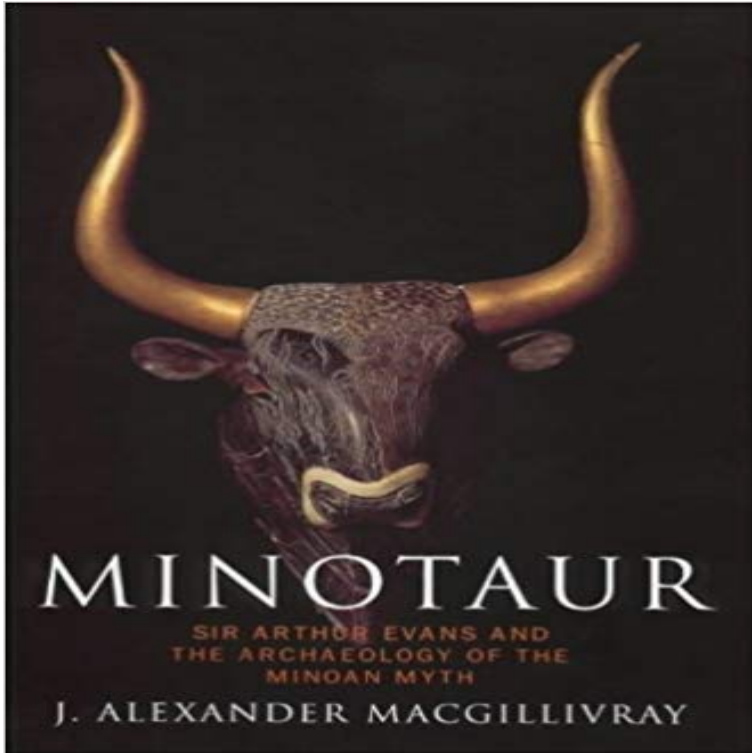


Minotaur: Sir Arthur Evans and the Archaeology of the Minoan Myth
