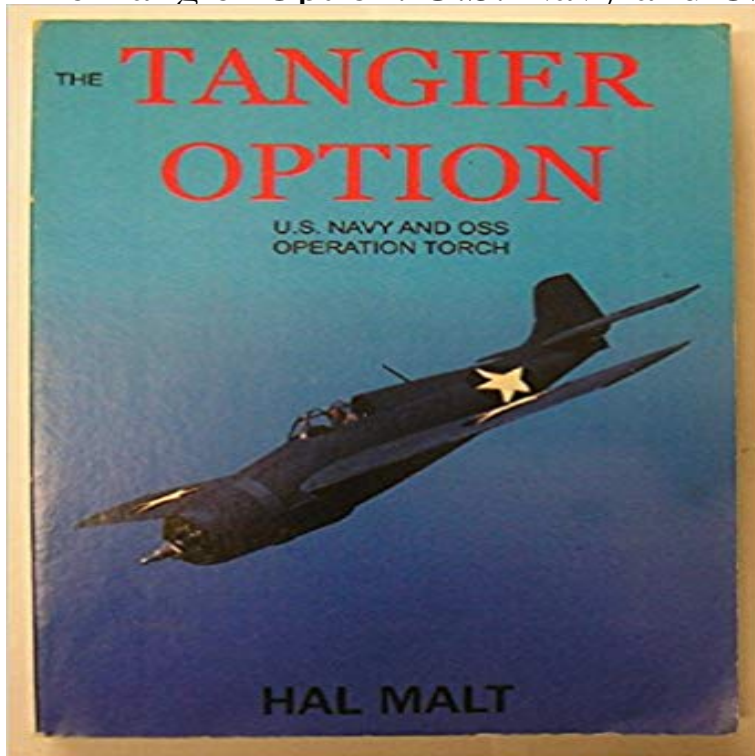


The Tangier Option: U.S. Navy and OSS Operation Torch
