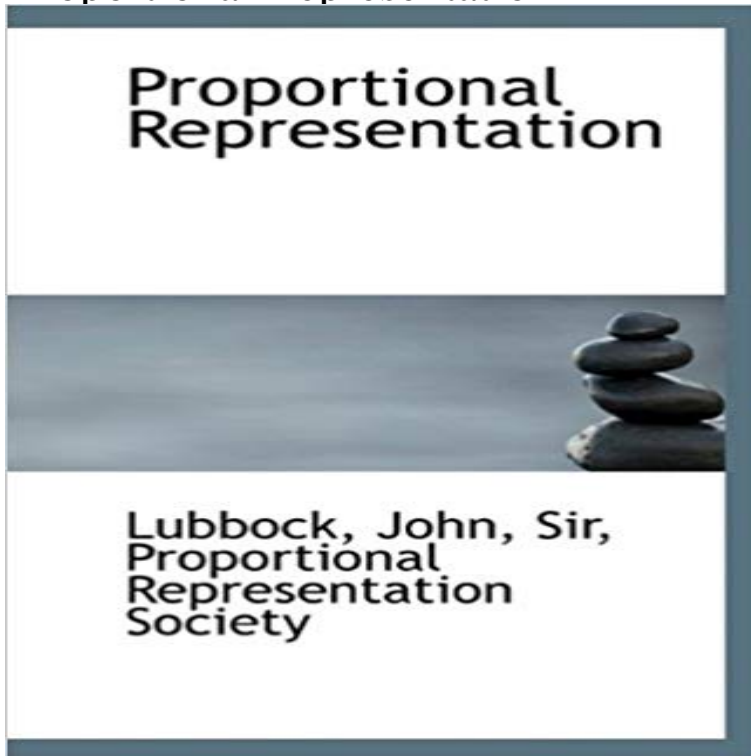


## Proportional Representation
