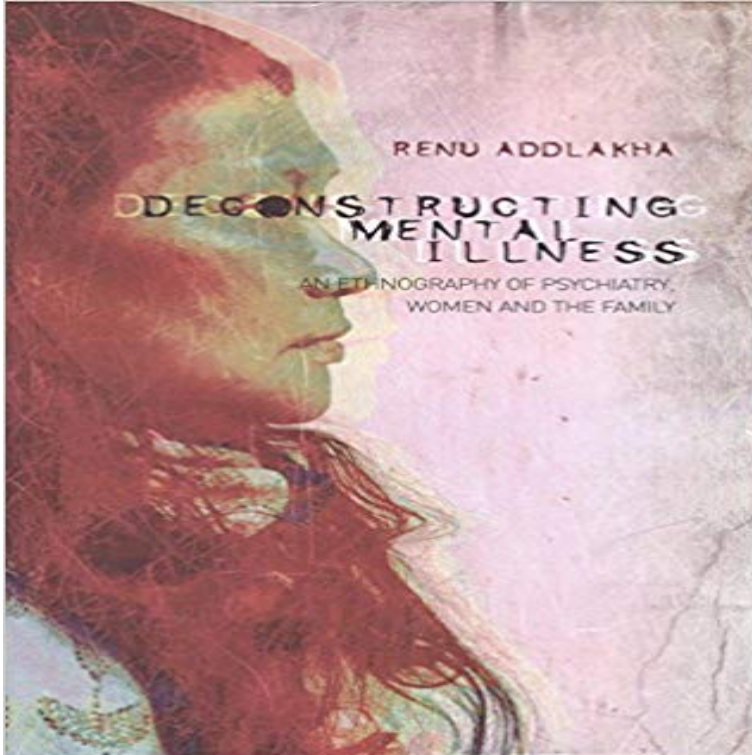


Deconstructing Mental Illness: An Ethnography of Psychiatry, Women, and the Family
