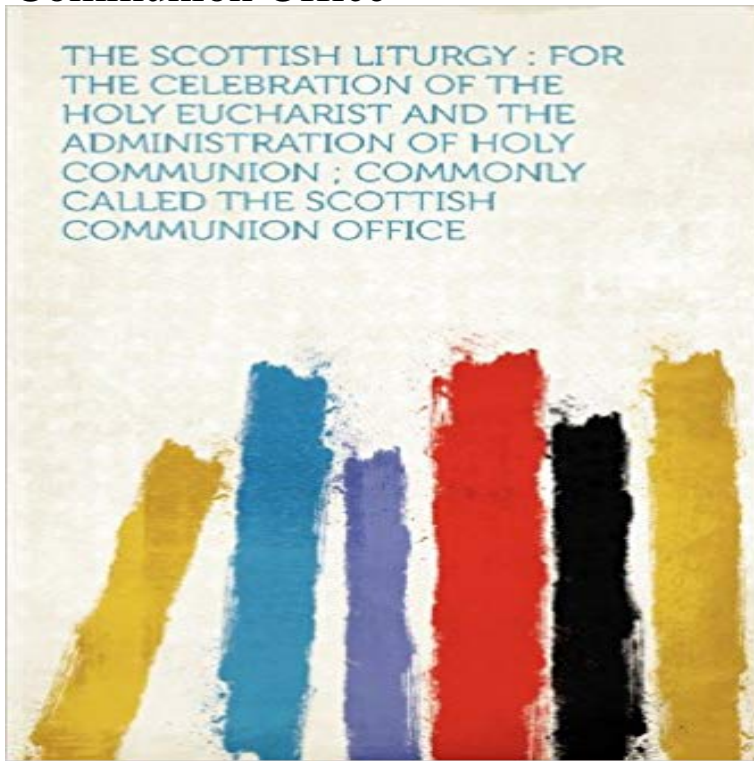


The Scottish Liturgy: for the Celebration of the Holy Eucharist and the Administration of Holy Communion ; Commonly Called the Scottish Communion Office
