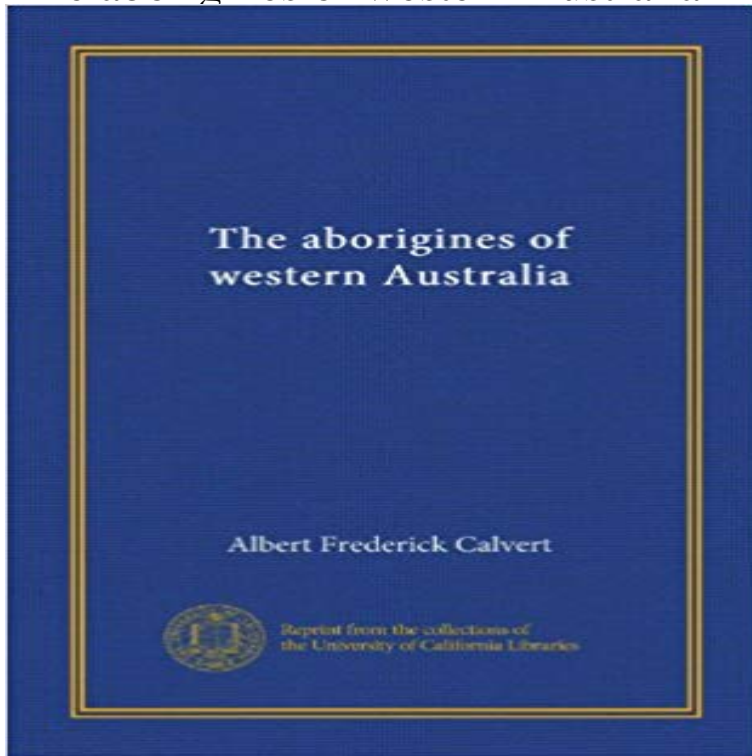


The aborigines of western Australia
