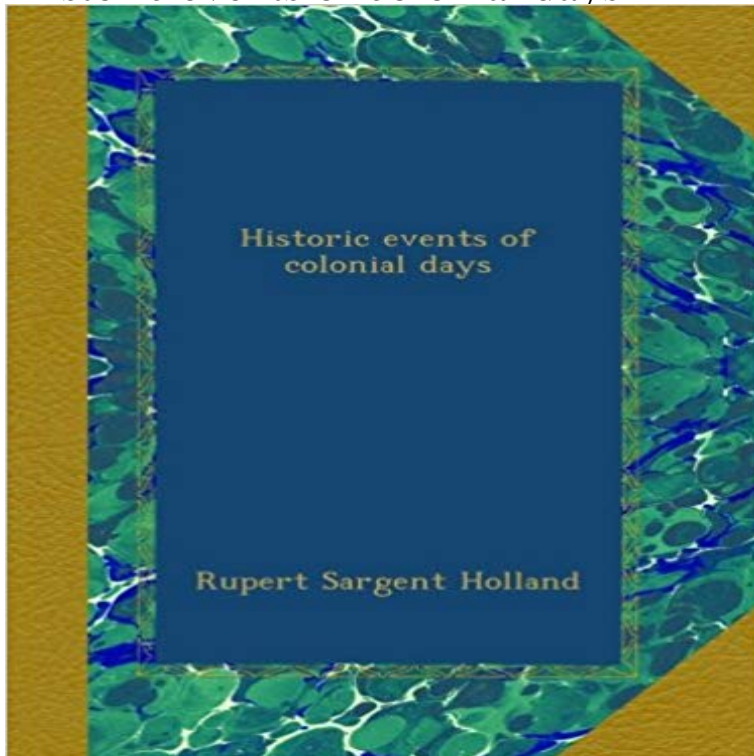


Historic events of colonial days
