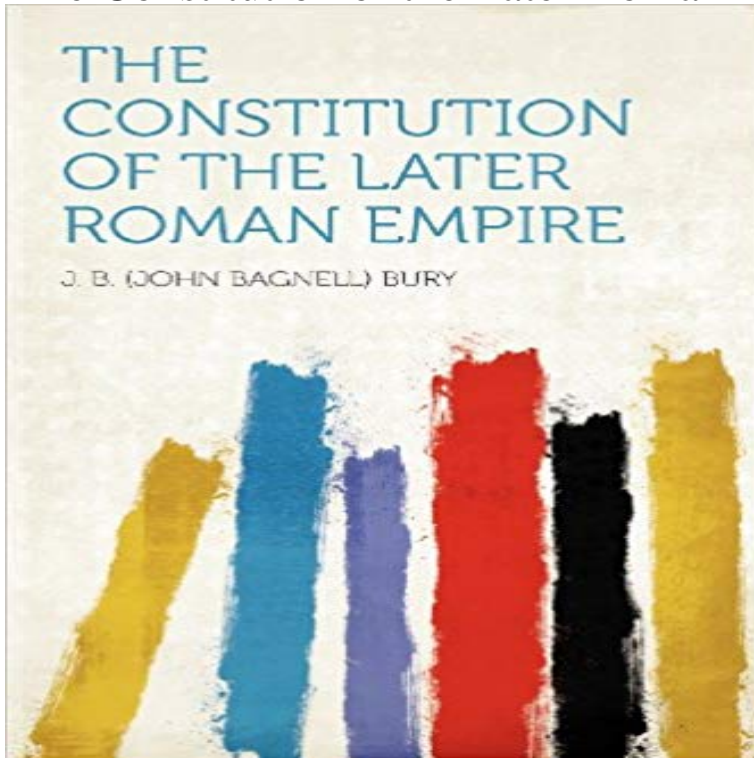


The Constitution of the Later Roman Empire
