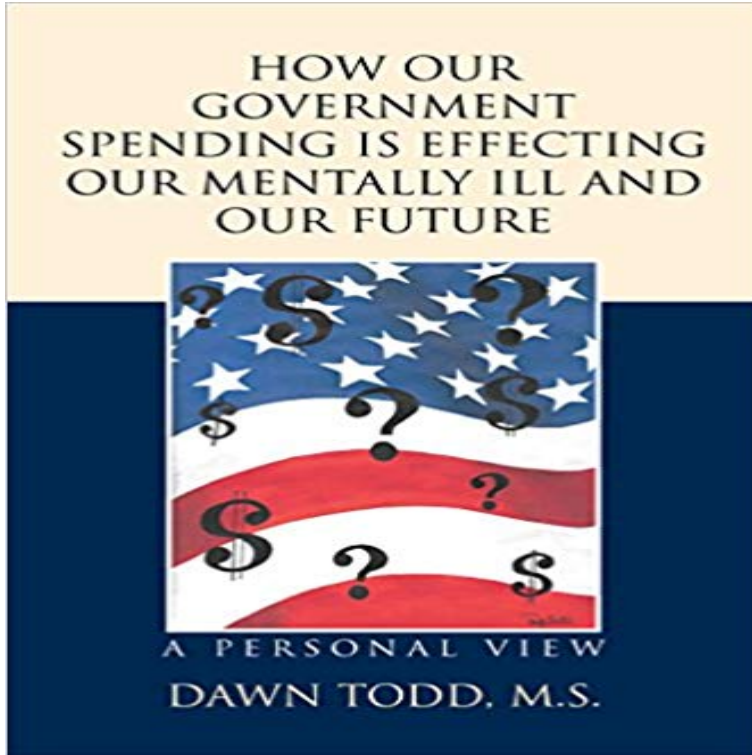


# How Our Government Spending Is Effecting Our Mentally Ill and Our Future: A Personal View
