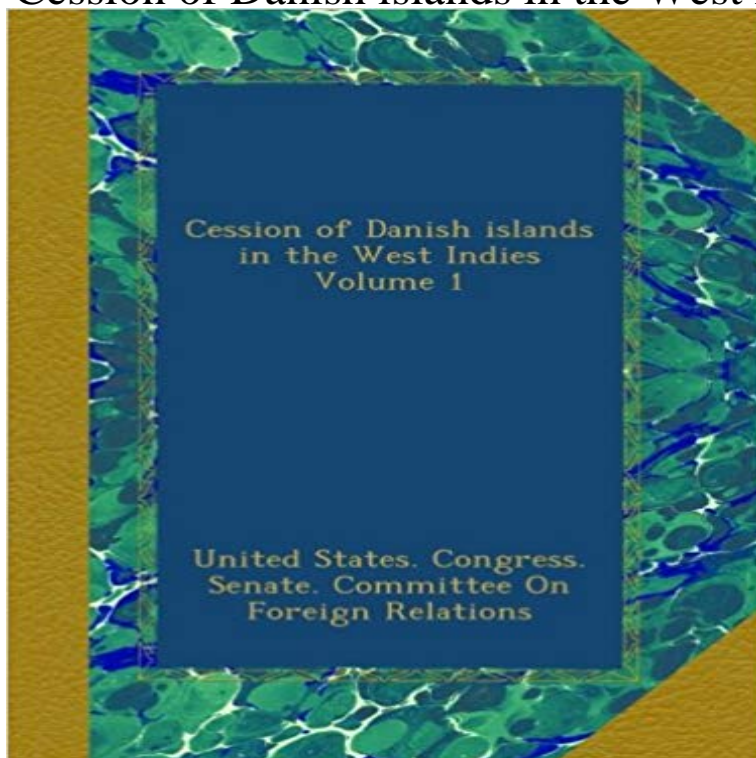


Cession of Danish islands in the West Indies Volume 1
