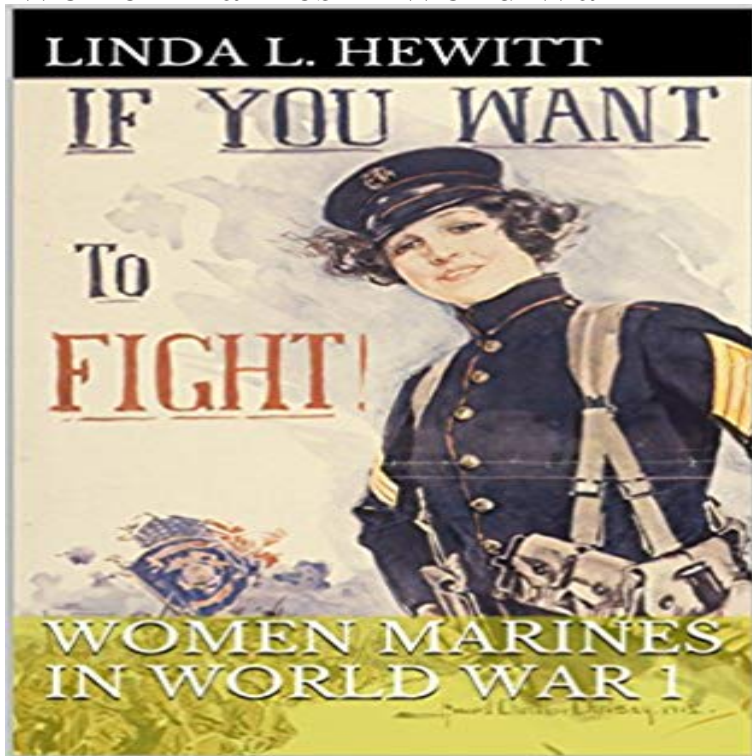


## Women Marines in World War 1
