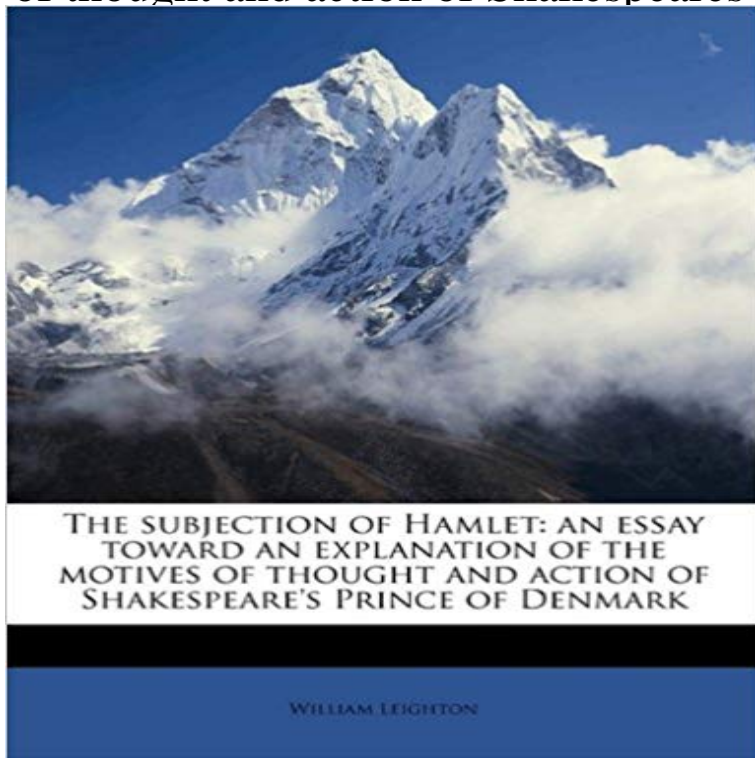


## The subjection of Hamlet: an essay toward an explanation of the motives of thought and action of Shakespeares Prince of Denmark
