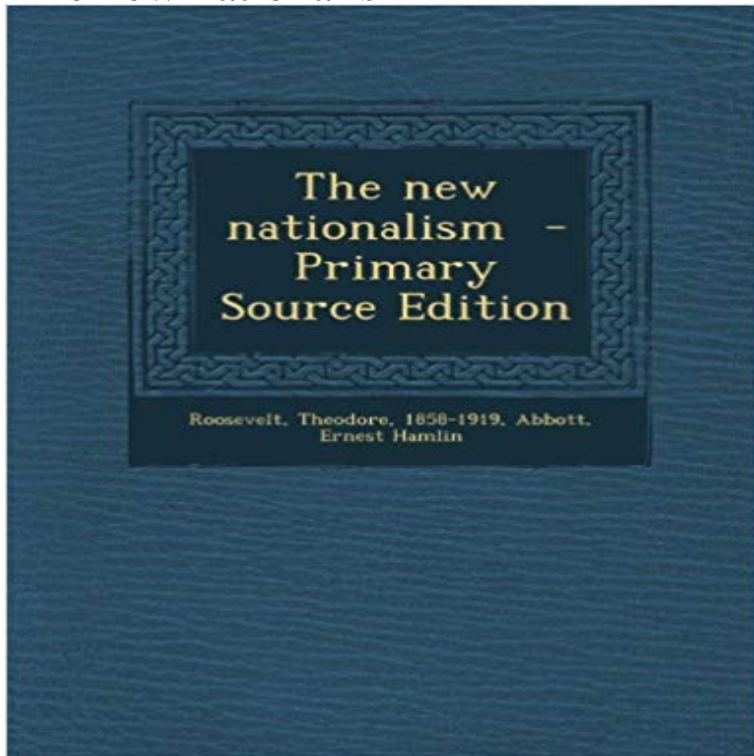


## The new nationalism
