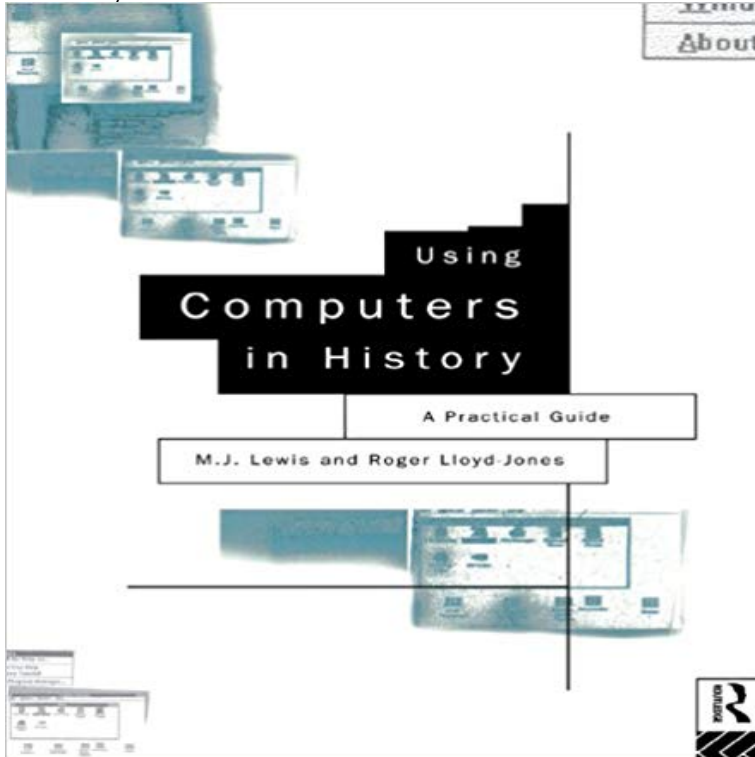


Using Computers in History: A Practical Guide to Data Presentation, Analysis and the Internet
